

## Colonel John T. Hughes 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment Missouri State Guard

On this spot, during the 1<sup>st</sup> Battle of Independence, on August 11, 1862, Colonel John T. Hughes, commander of the Confederate forces and Quantrill's Raiders, was killed. He was killed during the surprise attack against the Federal troops commanded by Lt. Colonel James T. Buel. At this location the attack was against Federal troops lead by Captains Breckinridge and Axline. Capt. Breckinridge was so taken unawares that he immediately shouted: "Boys, we are completely surrounded, and we had better surrender." This was the first command heard by the troops. Captain Axline was able to successfully counter the order and got the troops to rally a few yards from here behind a stone wall. It was from behind the stone wall that the fatal shot was fired, instantly killing Col. Hughes by a shot to the head.

John Taylor Hughes, born in Kentucky, soon moved to Missouri with his family. He was a college graduate, an educator, a teacher and later became a business man. He gained his military experience in 1848 during the Mexican War. He was one of many Missouri Citizen Soldier volunteers that took part in Alexander Doniphan's Expedition to Mexico. Hughes wrote the only major book on the history of the Mexican War, "Doniphan's Expedition". As a Colonel of the Missouri State Militia and the Missouri State Guard he participated in all the early Civil War battles in Missouri. At the time of his death he was in Missouri to recruit soldiers for the Confederate Armies.

Colonel John T. Hughes is buried in nearby Woodlawn Cemetery.

Your application for sales/use tax exempt status has been approved pursuant to Section 144.030.2(20), RSMo. This letter is issued as documentation of your organization's exempt status. The organization above must adhere to the exempt status requirements.

As noted above, this is an expiring exemption subject to legislative changes and review by the Director of Revenue. Outlined below are specific requirements regarding this exemption. - This exemption is not assignable or transferable. It is an exemption from sales and use taxes only and is not an exemption from real or personal property tax.
- Purchases by your organization are not subject to sales or use tax if conducted within your organization's exempt civic or charitable functions and activities. When purchasing with this exemption, furnish all sellers or vendors a copy of this letter.
- Individuals making personal purchases may not use this exemption.
- Agents or contractors may not claim or benefit from your organization's exempt status.
   Contractors paying for construction materials to fulfill a contract with your organization must pay sales tax on all such materials. Only purchases of construction materials that are directly billed to your organization may be purchased exempt from sales tax.
- Sales by your organization are not subject to sales or use tax if conducted within your organization's exempt civic or charitable functions and activities.
- Sales intended to raise funds, not related to the exempt function of your organization, may be exempt only if such sales are occasional or isolated sales.
- If your organization engages in a competitive commercial business that serves the general public, even if the profits are used for purposes of your exempt function, you must obtain a Missouri Retail Sales Tax License and collect and remit sales tax.
- Any alteration to this exemption letter renders it invalid.
