

## Chaplain's Corner, Hughes Camp Chaplain Richard W Rudd



Continued from June...

Last month's article dealt with how Satan plots to destruct us from living ethical lives. One tactic is to convince us to believe a lie and accept its shortterm advantages. Failing that, Satan resorts to two other tactics. Those who do not believe the lie and do not take the bait

Satan will try to silence. Unable to mount a credible defense against truth, those who do Satan's bidding seek to conceal the hypocrisy and irrationality of their intentions by silencing those who oppose them. The Jewish rulers and elders arrested Peter and John for publicly speaking "...and charged them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus." (Acts 4:18) Later, the Jewish council again arrested the apostles and "...beat them and charged them not to speak in the name of Jesus..." (Acts 5:40) The Nazis burned the books of authors they disliked. Lincoln closed newspapers and suspended habeas corpus to jail and silence opposition to his policies. Today Moslem nations ban the Bible from their lands. Freedom of speech, debate, and the exchange of ideas are discouraged on university campuses. Unpolitically correct messages are banned from the internet. The news media refuses to report what conflicts with the liberal agenda. History is being edited, revised, and censored to silence the voice of the dead and expunge their record. The Wuhan virus was used as a trial attempt to prevent the assembly of certain groups, especially churches. The author of Hebrews advised, "Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering...not neglecting to meet together, encouraging one another..." (Heb. 10:23) The strategy of divide and conquer is an attempt to prevent strength in numbers, mutual edification and support, and perseverance in loyalty to our beliefs and sense of duty.

In a final act of desperation, Satan removes the fist from the glove, resorting to forceful tactics. "On the evening of ...the first day of the week, the doors being shut where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews...," Christ's followers hid. (Jn. 20:19) Later, Nero persecuted Christians. After him, Diocletian burned the Holy Scriptures like the Nazis, closed churches and banned Christian assemblies like Moslems and Chinese Communists, and conducted the last major Roman persecution of Christians

in AD303. Today, anti-abortion facilities are vandalized, businesses that do not support sodomy are sued, employment is jeopardized, and public officials are prosecuted if they are not supportive of the liberal, secular agenda.

In the face of beguiling charm, voracious and incongruent lies, or bold intimidation and threats, we must cease to be "timid and afraid" and echo the words of Elihu, "I also will give my answer; I also will declare my opinion." "I must speak, that I may find relief; I must open my lips and answer." (Job 32:6, 17, 20) At Pentecost, after the advent of the Holy Spirit, the apostles, inspired with boldness and courage, spoke publicly to the people gathered in Jerusalem. The enemies of the Gospel were still present. "But Peter, standing with the eleven, lifted up his voice and addressed them, 'Men of Judea and all who dwell in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and give ear to my words." "So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about 3,000 souls." (Acts 2:14, 41) Who knows what possible effect our words might accomplish if we resist the convenience of silence and dare to demonstrate assurance, deny fear, and speak up in the face of opposition. But before we do so, we must be prepared, grounded in the knowledge of what we believe and why we believe it. "Always be prepared to make a defense to one who calls you to account..." (I Peter: 3:15) When Christ was tempted by Satan in the wilderness, He quoted scripture saying, "It is written..." (Matt. 4:1-When we are tempted, Christ advises us to follow His example, to know the truth and act in accordance with it. "Everyone then who hears these words and does them will be like a wise man ... " (Matt. 7:24) Our Confederate ancestors, though out-gunned, demonstrated their resolve and courage to defend the wisdom of their beliefs. Though that battle was lost, by their example they cast the die for our formation to continue the defense of the cause for which they sacrificed so much. As President Davis prophetically stated, "The principle for which we contend is bound to reassert itself, though it may be another time and another form."


