

What's been happening on the Western Front

Camp Meeting, October 14th

This month our speaker was *Tim Westcott*. I had listed Tim's name wrong on the calendar last month, must have gotten my wires crossed. But the topic I listed was correct!

Tim is a college history teacher. I failed to write down where. He teaches WBTS history from the Southern perspective, even though he is a descendant of Yankees. He said his students get a little antsi over that at first, because they've never heard that history taught from that perspective. But he lets them know how it really was to live in Missouri.

Tim said that there really isn't any detailed analysis of Order # 11. He is working on building a GPS mapping system using range and township info from the census records to plot where all homes were before Order # 11.

Union General John Scofield felt that the only way to rid Missouri of the "Guerilla Evil" was to purge the land of their support system and those who supported them.

Since the guerillas were mostly farm boys from western Missouri, 2/3rds of the people who lived in Jackson, Cass and Bates counties were related to the querillas!

The Union used several orders to exterminate or vacate the guerillas. Order # 32 said that

any guerilla caught would be shot. Order # 1 reinforced Order # 32. Order #10 directed Officers to arrest all men and women who gave aid to guerilla's.

After the burning of Lawrence, General Ewing issued Order # 11. Basically, anyone in those 3 counties that couldn't prove their loyalty beyond a shadow of a doubt was forced to leave their homes with what they could carry. Even loyal people were forced to move to within 5 miles of an Army post. Scofield urged Ewing not to go that far Ewing disagreed and Lincoln supported him.

As a result, the roads were crowded with women, children and old men. After the Jayhawkers took what they wanted from the houses, the torch was applied to all the homes. Bates County was completely vacated of it's 6000 residents. 3,589 of the 22,913 Jackson County residents were deported. Cass county was nearly wiped out, but I missed that stat. All this resulted in what was called "The burnt district". All that was left was the stone chimneys, which people called, "Jennison's Monuments". Errrrrr....



First off, Happy Veterans Day coming up on November 11th. Many of our Camp members are veterans or are currently serving. Thanks for your service past and present! November 11th is the date the Armistice was signed ending WWI. That was signed at 11 o'clock. 11-11-11. Cool.

Next, let's keep you up to speed with one of our members, Lt. Col. John P. Yeatman. John has been on active duty with the Air Force from last April or so to October. In that time frame, he has globetrotted all around the world in command of his KC-10 Extender. The KC-10 is a big savage beautiful bird. He has been all kinds of places, because where ever we have aircraft, we need aerial refueling! He's been to Hawaii, Wake Island, Guam, Okinawa, Japan, Al Dhafra, Midway. Basically doing the South Pacific tour, but also 30 or 60 days in the UAE flying combat missions over Afghanistan and Iraq.

While at Al Dhafra in the UAE, he sweated it out in the desert and flew at a high tempo ops pace. Fly, eat, sleep, fly again. He had to do a lot of mission planning also. In that time frame he racked up many **Strike Assist**. Refuelers are given a strike assist when they gas up bombers or fighters who then go in and wack the enemy. Several times he gave gas to a guy who immediately went in and provided close air support to our troops on the ground. John said that felt really good, knowing they were helping our guys out on the ground.

John has many great photos from the air of Afghanistan and Iraq. Afghanistan is amazing from the air. Rugged, desert, a vast wasteland of nothing! You can't believe the mountains. I didn't realize those are the Himalayan mountains. He has great shots from the refueling pod window, where you see the fighters etc getting gas with that vast wasteland below them. Maybe we'll get a power point show put together for you on that for a Camp Meeting.

John also drug many fighter squadrons across the pond, getting fighters to and from one side of the pacific to the other. He also did a stint at Edward's AFB, where he landed on the same runway as the space shuttle. He said it's a monster runway, they barely needed any of it! **Good job Lt. Colonel Yeatman!**

Chaplain's Corner, Hughes Camp Chaplain Richard W Rudd..



What is America's most dangerous and insidious threat? Consider how cancer works. The cells within one's own body produce out-of-control, malignant mutations that metastasize, spreading through the blood and lymph systems to attack other cells of the same body.

The church, the corporate body of Christ on earth, has never been without enemies within since its inception. Of Judas Iscariot, an apostle who sought and accepted a bribe to betray Christ, St. Luke said, "(H)e was numbered among us, and was allotted his share in this ministry." (Acts 1:17) By his own incriminating admission, Judas pleaded, "I have sinned in betraying innocent blood." (Matt. 27:4) Later, St. Paul spoke of being in "danger from false brethren..." (II Cor. 11:16) Naming two, he commented, "By rejecting conscience, certain persons have made shipwreck of their faith, among them Hymenaeus and Alexander..." (I Tim 1:19) Even today, Christ is still being betrayed and His church in America sabotaged from within. For example, the virgin birth of Christ, a required article of faith for every true Christian, has been denied by Harry Fosdick, former pastor of Riverside Church in NYC, Barnes Tatum, a professor at Greensboro College, Robert Funk, a founder of the infamous Jesus seminar, John Spong, a former Episcopal bishop, and Rob Bell, pastor of the large Mars Hill Church in Michigan. A 1998 survey of 7000 American clergymen reported that 79% of Congregationalists, 60% of Methodists, 49% of Presbyterians, 44% of Episcopalians, and 34% of Northern Baptists followed their apostate and heretical lead. It is no wonder that Christ predicted, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of Heaven..." (Matt. 7:21) Or, that St. Paul forewarned, "I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking perverse things to draw away the disciples after them." (Acts 20:29) Without a strong Christian faith and church, the foundation of America's culture, law, freedom, and strength is in jeopardy.

If internal threats exist within the church, how much more do they take root within a nation? Even while the US was being formed, Benedict Arnold, an officer in the

ranks of our revolutionary patriots, deserted for a bribe and sought to lure other Americans to desert the quest for independence. In another revolution for independence, the CSA struggled not only against the North, but also against scallywags within its borders and behind its lines who sympathized with the North. Today, Moslems, Communists, and illegal aliens threaten America. But our most dangerous and insidious threat comes from the spirits of Judas, Hymenaeus, Alexander, Arnold, and scallywags who live and work among us through their progeny. They are the "home-grown" terrorists, globalists, socialists, revisionists, and secular humanists who call themselves Americans. They are the ones who call themselves "progressives," but toward what are they progressing? They are the ones who call themselves "mainstream" America. If that were true, then one would have to say that the gutter has become the mainstream. As cited in my October article, the English historian Arnold Toynbee, after studying the rise and fall of civilizations, concluded that most disintegrated from internal weakness more often than external force; they committed suicide.

These mutant, malignant, out-of-control cells among us metastasize through the veins in which the lifeblood of America flows-our churches, government, schools, corporate boards, publishing houses, media, and entertainment. They attack the very body from which they draw their sustenance and energy. They are the most effective when they are the least detected. Of such, Christ said, "You will know (detect) them by their fruits." (Matt. 7:16) Listen to and question what they say. Observe how they live and question what they do. Learn what motivates them. St. John advised, "(D)o not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are of God..." (I Jn. 4:1) What they fear most is exposure and unrelenting challenge from those who know, practice, and are not afraid to speak the truth of Christ.
