What’s been happening on the Western Front

Camp Meeting, February 8th...

Our speaker in February was **Dwayne Holtzclaw** and his subject was ***Captain Theodor Duncan***. Many of you may remember that Captain Duncan is buried beside the Liberty Confederate Grave Marker, and Captain Duncan was the first Clay County man killed in the war.

Dwayne also discussed some of Captain Duncan’s relatives and connections to folks around here. Captain Duncan’s time in the war was short, due to how early he was killed. What happened was, Elijah Gates swept into the area around Smithville, called District 5, to gather up Missouri Home Guard recruits. They were thinking about going to Lexington. While they were on the move, a madman in their own ranks shot and killed Duncan. The guy’s name James Daniel Askew. I believe Dwayne said he was arrested and court martialed, and executed.

Dwayne’s family owned 4000 acres near present day Smithville Lake. The Lake covers part of that former land. There is a Holtzclaw Creek, that flows into Crow’s Creek, which runs into Smithville Lake. Both are right near Yeatman’s home!

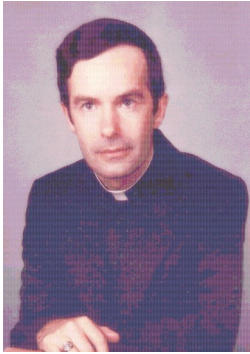


HONOR THEM.

Chaplain's Corner, Hughes Camp Chaplain Richard W Rudd



Recorded history verifies that the spirit of Nimrod has continued to plague humanity. From the schoolyard bully to the international tyrant, the aggressive desire to invade the living space of others for control has motivated Nimrod's imitators. Hitler, one of the most notorious, expressed this spirit best when he wrote that aggressors

"...must not let political boundaries obscure us..." and that "...what is refused to amicable methods, it is up to the fist to take." (Mein Kempf) Like those who first assembled together in the city of Babel, so today major metropolitan urban areas are predominantly defined by liberal secular ideologies; humanity placing faith in itself, vanity generated by the accumulation of collective knowledge and physical strength, instead of faith in God to accomplish their aspirations. Today, the pinnacle of Nimrod's spirit is epitomized by globalism, the scheme to obliterate all distinctions among humanity, including gender, race, and nationality, to create one people under a one-world government.

The spirit of Nimrod is currently exemplified by two events dominating world news. One concerns the war in the Ukraine. Situated between Russia to the east and Germany and Austria to the west, the Ukraine and other Slavic nations have been repeatedly invaded and dominated by foreign powers. Soon after the 1917 revolution in Russia, the Communists sought to incorporate the Ukraine and its neighbors into the Soviet Union. This was challenged by Hitler, who sought Lebensraum (living space) in eastern Europe. After the disintegration of the Soviet Union, the Ukraine achieved independence, but has been unable to exist in peace with Russia and has been invaded and forced to fight a defensive war for its land and independence.

The history of the CSA is similar to the history that is being made in the Ukraine. As the Ukraine was once part of the Soviet Union, so the CSA was once part of the US Union. The CSA achieved independence as the Ukraine did. The Ukraine was not permitted to exist in peace beside Russia; the CSA could not peacefully co-exist with the North. Putin invaded the Ukraine; Lincoln, who corresponded with Marx, invaded the CSA which was also forced to fight a defensive battle for its land

and independence. It is ironic how so many Americans who sympathize with the Ukraine remain blind or stubbornly refuse to admit the parallel with the WBTS and continue to libel the CSA.

The second current event inflamed by Nimrod's spirit continues to blaze in the Middle East. Israel is the only nation to which God has given a land grant, the deed recorded in the holy Torah. "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." (Gen. 1:1) Thus, "The earth is the Lord's and the fulness thereof..." (Ps. 24:1), I Cor. 10:26) Only He has the moral authority to make land grants to those He wishes, which He did to the Jewish people. "Now the Lord said to Abram, 'Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land which I will show you. And I will make you a great nation...'" (Gen. 12:1) On his arrival there, "The Lord said to Abram.... 'Lift up your eyes and look from the place where you are, northward and southward and eastward and westward; for all the land that you see I will give you and to your descendants forever.'" (Gen. 13:15) "Then the Lord appeared to Abram, and said, 'To your descendants I will give this land.'" (Gen. 12:7) "On that day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying, 'To your descendants I give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates...'" (Gen. 15:18) Consequently, the Torah, specifically Genesis, is the Israelites' sacred deed to the land they possess today.

Over the last approximately 3900 years, various people have challenged the Israelite's possession of their land. The most notable in world history have been Assyria (721 BC), Babylon (597 BC), and Alexander III of Macedonia (332 BC), followed by his successor the evil Seleucid Antiochus Epiphanes of Syria. Next came Rome (63 BC), the Islamic Arabs (636), followed by the Seljuks and Turks (1072, 1187, 1516), and finally Britain. In 1948, Jews re-occupied their homeland and have successfully repelled numerous attacks from surrounding Moslem nations. The most recent attacks being launched from Gaza Oct. 7, 2023.

Again, parallels with the CSA persist. Once, the Holy Land was an integral part of the Middle East, as the South was with the North, until God set it apart as a homeland for the Israelites. Israel's independence is threatened, and its land continues to be invaded and attacked by

Although military combat ceased in 1865, the South continues to be attacked for all it fought and still stands for in America. The last remaining places dedicated to the Confederacy, locations of monuments and graves, are now being desecrated, vandalized, and ownership contested. But it will not stop there. The ultimate intention is to eradicate from the land of America all who defend southern culture, conservative values, and moral standards of a Judaeo-Christian society. Intent on not only possessing the land of Israel but also destroying the Jews, Moslems chant "from the river (Jordan) to the sea (Mediterranean)." When those marching in the streets of America in support of Moslem terrorists repeat the lyrics of America the Beautiful "from sea (Atlantic) to shining sea (Pacific), they have made the meaning they apply to those words unmistakably clear.
